WORLD-FAMOUS SEVEN MILE BEACH



The beach in the Cayman Islands, known as Seven Mile Beach, is ranked as one of the top beaches world wide. This pristine beach can be spotted from an aerial shot as you fly into the island. There are restaurants, bars, water sports and snorkel reefs along this famous landmark. This is the most developed area of Grand Cayman. The Sunset Cove resort property (pictured in photo above), is on the southern end of Seven Mile Beach conveniently located less than 1 mile from the restaurants and duty-free shops in George Town.



Most major airlines have flights to/from Grand Cayman (GCM). From Miami, Grand Cayman is only a little over an hour's flight time. A valid passport is required.
